### I. AIMS Field Worker Qualifications and Expectations:

1. Affirmed and sent by a local church or approved mission agency.
2. Completed the AIMS **Introduction To Strategic Missions** training course, all 9 modules.
3. Trained in basic doctrine, discipleship, evangelism, and church planting movements (CPMs) among the Unreached.
4. Committed to a specific Unreached People Group (UPG).
5. Participate in ongoing training with AIMS.
6. Initiate Holistic Sustainability projects in partnership with AIMS.
7. Initiate evangelism, discipleship, and church planting among your UPG.
8. Submit required quarterly reports on the UPGs you are working with, whether funded or not.

### II. AIMS Partnership Benefits:

1. Access to ongoing training and materials through your personalized username and password on the AIMS website, or through the AIMS Coordinator for your area.
2. Personal listing as an AIMS Field Worker in the AIMS database.
3. Personal and ongoing interaction with the AIMS Team to provide ongoing development and networking resources.
4. Help in mobilizing your **Faith Promise Giving** training to generate finances for the work of missions among your adopted UPG and increase missions sending capability.
5. Connection to a worldwide network of UPG-focused ministries and holistic ministries aiding your Great Commission efforts.
6. Possible financial partnership through AIMS toward your specific UPG focus.
7. Opportunity to become certified as an AIMS Trainer using AIMS training materials.

**III. Financial Guidelines and Expectations: (Please check after reading each point.)**

- As an AIMS Field Worker, soliciting funding from partners in the AIMS database is strictly prohibited. Do not contact AIMS partners for money.
- AIMS does not assume responsibility, nor does it commit to providing financial support.
- Under specified circumstances, financial partnership with AIMS is possible for your specific UPG focus.
- UPG Adoption funding is one-year “seed money” to be used for the work of evangelism and church planting among the specified UPG. Commitment of funds is not guaranteed beyond the one-year period.
- Field Workers of AIMS are expected to apply AIMS principles such as Faith Promise Giving, Networking through Partnership, and Goers and Senders.
- Any funding that goes to a Field Worker is contingent upon the field worker submitting quarterly progress reports through the AIMS website or their Coordinator. (No reports – no support.)

**IV. AIMS Field Worker Accountability Standards: (Please check after reading each point.)**

- AIMS will work directly with your Regional Coordinator to help provide effective accountability.
- Complete the required quarterly reports through your personal login account at [www.aims.org](http://www.aims.org).
- Communicate regularly with the AIMS Team on the progress of your UPG efforts and needs.
- Identify holistic partners working near your UPG who could become potential partners with AIMS and communicate that with the AIMS Team.
